Description

- Peers with a Purpose is a facilitated social group focused on participants' specific social and behavioral needs.
- Group members will meet weekly and work together to participate in a community experience with a positive purpose for an individual, group or organization. While working on projects, group members will have the opportunity to work on their personal goals with the support of a typical peer.
- Facilitators implement research based strategies in Peer Mediated Intervention and Cognitive Behavior Therapy.
- Peers are typical peers from area high schools.
- Group members will practice conversational skills and social thinking.

Who

- Designed for individuals 13 - 18 years old with moderate cognitive and/or social behavioral impairments.
- Group members should demonstrate effective basic conversational skills
