### Get Organized & On the Right Track

#### Description

The program is:

- designed for boys and girls between the ages of 10 and 14 years diagnosed with ADHD, or who may have difficulties with executive functioning skills
- designed to improve organizational and study skills
- designed to build resilience and improve overall problem solving in relation to school difficulties
- designed to promote self-esteem through positive peer, teacher and familial interaction
- facilitated by Rachel Pasquerilla, EdS, BCBA and Lindsey Tornow, EdS, BCBA
- designed to have a maximum of 4-6 children per group

#### How

The program promotes strategies for organization and school success through two methods:

- **Parental Involvement**- provides suggestions and feedback to parents about new ways of relating to their child with ADHD and executive functioning difficulties.
- **Student Involvement**- provides direct instruction for students to learn organizational and study strategies, combined with practice in making new agreements with parents.

Treatment goals are specifically tailored to meet the needs of the group.

#### Targeted skills and topics may include:

- Learning the nature of ADHD
- Managing stress/school demands
- Learning organizational skills
- Negotiating
- Effectively communicating
- Problem solving
- Making new commitments
- Developing positive peer and parental interactions

#### Who

- Early Adolescent (ages 10-14).
- Children who are managing ADHD concerns and related organizational difficulties
- Children have primary placement in a regular education setting
- Children have generally average speech and language skills.
